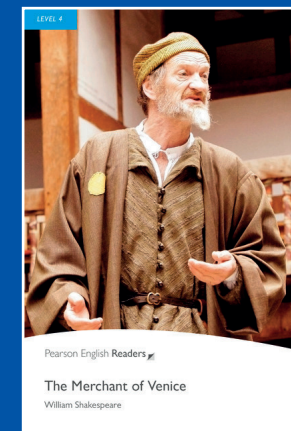
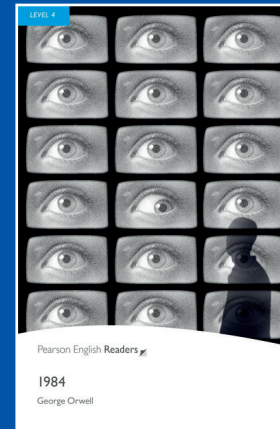


Speakout
